



NOTICE OF RACE

Entries are invited from single handed and doubled handed dinghies to sail in the Adrian Carter Memorial Regatta.

Organised by Milton Keynes Sailing Club.
To be held on Sunday 8th July.

Location: Caldecotte Lake, Milton Keynes.

RULES

The regatta will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020, the Prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association, Class Rules and the MKSC Sailing Instructions.

Racing Rules 27.1 and 40 will be changed to the effect that buoyancy aids are required.

Competitors should note that MKSC implements the RYA Racing Charter and that they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found at the front of the RYA rule book.

ELIGIBILITY

No sailboards or multi-hulls or craft.

Helm and crew must be under 18 on 8th July 2018.

Boats and crew to be confirmed upon Registration on the morning of the racing from 09:30hrs.

Changes may be made after that, at the Race Officer's discretion, if:

- a) The original boat is damaged beyond immediate repair.
- b) The helm is unable to continue due to illness or injury.

ENTRY FEE AND SCHEDULE

The entry fee for this event will be £5 per person.

Boats will sail in two fleets – a Fast handicap and Slow handicap fleets – the split between fleets to be decided on the day, in order to balance numbers in each fleet as far as practical.

Briefing 10.45hrs 1st Race start 11.00hrs 2nd Race start 13.30hrs 3rd Race start 14.30hrs

Prize giving as soon as possible after the last race.

SCORING

The Low Point scoring system of Appendix A will apply, three races, **all three to count**.

Tie breaks in individual competition: Highest number of first places per boat, highest number of second places per boat, etc. Where a tie remains it will be broken in favour of the boat with the lowest score in the last race in which the tied boats race and scored differently.

DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. MKBYSA and Milton Keynes Sailing Club will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of at least £2,000,000 or the equivalent.

PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to the winner of the Fast Handicap Fleet and the Slow Handicap.
